RULES and PROGRAM

INDIVIDUAL UPHILL TIME TRIAL

Friday 25 August 2023 – Castelnovo né Monti

The Individual Time Trial on 25 August 2023 is included in the UCI Gran Fondo World Series 2023 calendar. The race allows the top finishers (25% of the starters in each category) to qualify for the UCI Gran Fondo World Championships 2024.

PARTECIPATION

The event is open to all F.C.I. members and sports promotion bodies in possession of medical fitness for competitive cycling and to foreign cyclists in possession of a UCI licence valid for the year 2023 issued by their own Federation and subject to presentation of ethical certification in English and certificate of fitness drawn up in accordance with model E.

Open to members of organisations that have signed an agreement with the FCI for the year 2023 and to members of organisations that present their Bike Card together with their organisation's membership card.

The event is also open to all non-members for whom an F.C.I. day card will be activated at a cost of €10.00 for insurance cover for "third-party civil liability" during the event. For the day card to be issued, a competitive sports medical certificate (cycling certificate) must be presented and the ethics certificate signed. The medical certificate must not be more than one year older than the date of the event in which you intend to participate.

The event is open to all persons aged 19 (nineteen) years and over.

The event is free of charge, but the Organising Committee may at any time and at its sole discretion decide whether or not to accept an entry, or exclude an entrant from the event in the event it may damage its image.

All participants are aware of the various risks to their physical safety and consciously assume responsibility for participating in the race at their own risk.

In all circumstances, cyclists must pay the utmost attention to road conditions.

The event applies the 2021 FCI implementing regulations for cycling activities. Recalling the UCI and FCI regulations, the race jury with the technical support of the organisation is authorised to carry out random or systematic checks. Non-compliance or refusal to submit to the required technical checks will result in immediate disqualification and reporting to the competent authorities.

ETHICAL REQUIREMENT AND TECHNOLOGICAL FRAUD

By signing and submitting the registration form, the competitor, together with the representative of his team, self-certifies the non-existence of any sporting, civil and/or criminal sanctions or ongoing investigations against him for doping-related offences and declares that he has not taken - and does not take - substances included on the World Anti Doping Agency (WADA) Prohibited List | World Anti Doping Agency (wada-ama.org) anti-doping list. False self-certification will be prosecuted under the law.

In the event of a non-negative anti-doping and/or mechanical anti-doping control, the competitor will be sued by the Organising Committee in the appropriate forums with a claim for compensation, for the serious damage caused to the image of the event. In the event that the competitor belongs to a Sports Association, the latter will be jointly and severally liable to pay any penalty, if proven to be jointly responsible.

The event will apply the 2023 implementation rules for national cycling and amateur activities. Recalling the UCI and FCI Regulations, paragraph 1.3.010 and 12.4.003 technology fraud, the race jury, with the technical support of the organisers, is authorised to carry out random or systematic checks. Non-compliance or refusal to submit to the required technical checks will result in immediate disqualification and reporting to the competent bodies. Furthermore, referring to the UCI and FCI Regulations (Implementation Rules point 1.1.9.) it is hereby made known that the use of any two-way radio equipment is strictly prohibited.

PARTICIPATION FEE

The participation fee is non-reducible and non-refundable and includes: registration fee, insurance, final refreshments, medical assistance. **The commemorative gadget of the event is not included.**

In order to be detected and classified, the athlete must be equipped with his/her own OneChip© chip. At the time of collecting the race packet those who do not have their own chip can hire it on payment of € 10.00, of which € 5.00 is a guarantee deposit which will be returned when the chip is returned at the end of the event: hand over the chip to the registration officials who will be available in the finish area. Registration implies full acceptance of the present document.

CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION

Should a member be unable to participate, the registration fee will only be kept valid for the following year. Notification must reach granfondo@cooperatori.it by 25 May 2023. The registration fee is non-refundable.

CANCELLATION OF COMPETITION

The race will take place in all weather conditions, except in special cases, assessed by the organiser at his discretion, that seriously endanger the safety of the competitors or in the event of natural disasters (and in any case for causes not attributable to the organiser). In this case, half of the participation fee will be kept valid for the next edition.

PARTECIPATION GRID

UCI grids by age category.

ATTENTION: It will not be possible to start in front of the mats. Those who do not have the marks on the starting mats and on the course will be excluded from the classifications.

The organisation reserves the right to make changes to the grids at any time at its sole discretion and in agreement with the UCI.

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

The competitor must always respect the checkpoints provided on the routes under penalty of exclusion from the final classification. All roads will be temporarily closed to traffic as per decree issued by the competent local safety authorities, however, the strict observance of and compliance with the rules of the Highway Code shall apply.

All participants, throughout the duration of the race, must wear a homologated hard helmet and carry the race number displayed on the handlebars clearly visible and not rolled up on the frame and a back number provided by the organisation. These numbers may not be changed in format. In order to protect the environment, it is absolutely forbidden for participants to throw rubbish of any kind along the roads; it is compulsory to place it exclusively in the special containers located near the refreshment posts and/or at the finish line. Anyone caught by the organisation staff and/or race officials not respecting this rule will be penalised according to the regulations, up to and including disqualification.

For anything not covered by these regulations, the F.C.I. National Amateur Structure regulations shall apply. Admirals and/or accompanying motorbikes are not permitted.
